

LETTER FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER

Tim Lawson, the Golf Professional and GM at Pinnacle, Gaylord Walden, the Golf Professional at Athens CC and I have been talking about creating a golf tournament that would encompass all three clubs. The three-way tournament would rotate between clubs and possibly be held in November. Scoring for the tournament would be with the Stableford Points system. On a similar note, we would still play our match play event against Pinnacle during August and I would like to add a match play competition against Athens during the summer, possibly in July.

As you may know, Pinnacle is closed on Tuesdays but open on Mondays. In the past, our members have been able to play Pinnacle on Mondays for a cart fee and Pinnacle members have been able to play our course on Tuesdays for the same fee. Also, you were able to make you own tee times at Pinnacle on Mondays. Going forward, that policy will remain in place. However, Tim and I have also decided to extend play at our respective clubs, through the entire week, for the same cart fee only price. The only difference for Wednesday through Sunday play is that our respective pro shop staff must make the tee times for our members to play at the other facility. Show up unannounced and you may be expected to pay the full guest fee. So, please remember to ask Stephen or myself to call Pinnacle on your behalf.

Another golfing opportunity that I hope our members will take advantage of is The Tempest, located about .5 miles north of I20 on Hwy 135 towards Gladewater, Texas. The Tempest is a multi-million-dollar renovation of an older course by the name of Shallow Creek. While all 18 holes have been rebuilt, 12 of the course's original 18 holes have been completely re-routed to take advantage of the terrain's many elevation changes. Our members can take advantage of a discounted rate of \$20.00 off regular greens fees, weekday or weekend. Once again, please ask the pro shop staff to make your tee time arrangements. When you finish playing, stop by the Country Tavern on Hwy 31, less than 15 minutes from The Tempest. Their bar-be-que is excellent.

GOLF COURSE DRAINAGE FUND RAISER

As most of our golfing members are aware, we have several areas around our greens that don't drain very well. So, the Green's Committee has decided to address many of these drainage issues this spring. Dewayne has put together a plan with an estimate of \$5,000.00 to relieve the following areas:

Greens

- #1 Across the front of the green and take the water down the left side into the trees.
- #6 Two lines across the front and right side of the green.
- #8 The right side of the green.
- #10 Across the front of the green.
- #11 Across the back center of the green.
- #12 Left side of the green and the back area.
- #14 Right front of the green.
- #16 Left grass bunker area and around the front of the green.
- #17 Front right area between the green and bunker.

Dewayne will work mainly on Mondays, attempting to complete one or two holes per day as to not disrupt play. He plans on beginning the project on in a few weeks.

The year of 2019 is off to a running start.

Your golf course staff has pretty much completed our leaf issue around the course. We are continuing to remove saplings from trees and removing dead hazardous trees along the way.

Our greens surfaces have been sprayed with herbicides to kill out the POA annua that has emerged, a second application will be applied later this month.

Now that we have received a few nights of below freezing temperatures our Bermuda grass should be dormant enough to start spraying all fairways and roughs with post and pre-emergent to control our weeds without harming the turf.

We are continuing to rebuild our mowing equipment and installing new sprinklers on a daily basis, along with other improvements around your course.

Come out and enjoy a round of golf before temperatures become unbearable!
