## LETTER FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER

**From the Pro Shop:** Overall, our golf course was in good shape throughout the year. Dewayne and his crew have once again done a great job and they are also well on their way to having the new sprinkler heads installed. However, in late October, we discovered that we have a Nematode issue with our greens. Nematodes, in short, are microscopic worms. Some nematodes are good, and some can be very bad. Dewayne has sent soil samples for each green for testing and we have discovered that some of our greens are heavily infested with 'Bad' nematodes. Nematodes can be controlled chemically, and Dewayne was able to treat the greens twice before the growing season ended. Dewayne was pleased to report that we had some recovery before the greens went dormant. We will re-test the greens in early spring and will probably retreat them twice next year, once in the spring and then in August. Periodic future testing is planned.

**Manager's Notes:** Over the past three years our membership has grown from a low of 272 members in January 2016 to 352 currently. Improvements in the irrigations system, tree thinning and rebuilding several tee boxes should all add up to better golfing experiences for all in 2019. All of this could not have been possible without a lot of hard work from your club's fine staff. Everyone listed below has played an integral part in our positive outcome this year. It doesn't matter if the staff is maintaining the course, keeping the club house clean or working in the administrative office, please take the time to thank them whenever you have a chance. They will all appreciate your acknowledgement.
