This great event is for kids and kids-at-heart, 6-years-old and older (all teams will need to have an adult present to compete). Cedar Creek Country Club has cardboard available on a first come first serve basis.

## **Race Rules:**

- I. All Boats must be registered by Wednesday, August 29th at 5:00PM.
- II. All participants must be able to swim
- III. Only approved materials may be used for construction of your boat. Boats will be subject to inspection by the race committee for compliance with these rules.
- IV. Paddles will not be supplied to participants on race day (craft your own). No electrical motors, gasoline engines, or sails may be used.
- V. Boat dimensions should not exceed 4.5ftX3ftX1.5ft. Passenger area of the boat must not be enclosed above the shoulder.
- VI. Water craft must be safe for occupants and other boaters. No sharp edges or anything the judges feel is posing a danger is permitted.
- VII. Hulls may not be "wrapped" in plastic, duct tape or anything else. Joints and seams may be glued or taped.
- VIII. Participants must retrieve their boats (or its remains!) from the water and dispose of them properly.
- IX. Any boat/crew not ready to race at their designated times will be automatically disqualified.
- X. Destruction of other participants boats is expressly prohibited—especially by poor losers who have already sunk.

## **Race Format:**

Boats will need to be designed to carry 1 individual and allow for easy transition in and out of water

Teams consist of 2 individuals with an alternate if needed (racer and someone on land to assist with direction change and take off)

Teams will start in starting location, teams will navigate the course returning to their starting location.

Teammates who are not in the boat may help push the boat away from the pool deck both at the beginning of the race and during the half way switch

The race must begin and end with the two – person crew intact

Swimming and/or pulling the boat, or the use of the wall or other boats will result in disqualification

Heats will consist of, at most, 4 boats at a time

Each boat will travel roughly 40 yards (two circuits of the pool)

Time from heats will determine placement for finals. The fastest 3 times from heats will race for the Boating Champion



## **Design Tips:**

Boat dimensions should not exceed 4.5ftX3ftX1.5ft Set your goal: Design, Speed, Looks, all of the above? Sketch out your design

Flat bottoms, sit-to-paddle, are the easiest
Rudders help keep you straight but make turning difficult and add complexity to your design

Reinforce the area where you sit or kneel
